# Promiseland

We believe that Sunday School is an important part of a child's spiritual development. Our Sunday School program, called Promiseland, provides an excellent opportunity for children to learn about the Bible, about God's love for them, and to begin their own faith journey.

At Friendship Community Church, families take part in worship together for the first part of the service in a welcoming environment. Children are then dismissed to Promiseland where they learn spiritual truths from a variety of workshops, including art, drama and games.

# Classes

Promiseland is for children ages **three (3) to Grade 5**. Our goal is to work as a team with families to help children *LEARN Biblical truths, GROW in faith and LIVE OUT their faith in the community.*

**Preschool** – Our preschool class includes children age three, four and five year olds not yet in kindergarten.



**Kindergarten to Grade 5** – After being dismissed from the service, the Kindergarten to Grade 5 children meet for an open group session before going to their workshop for that Sunday. During this time, we sing songs, celebrate birthdays and participate in some



type of service project locally or globally.

After the open group session, children split into small groups based on age (**K/1, 2/3, 4/5 Boys & 4/5 Girls**) and go to their workshop for that Sunday; for example, art, drama or cooking. Children explore the same Bible story over the course of 4 to 5 weeks through these various workshops.

# Registration

If you are new to Friendship and would like to register your child(ren) for Promiseland, then registration forms are available at the sign-in table in Kratofil Hall. Once children are registered, they will be added to our class lists and name tags will be made for them.
